80 Years of Impact

Video Contest

1. Contest Description:

The Air Force Aid Society's (AFAS) "80 years of impact" Video Contest is centered around showing how AFAS has impacted you. We have partnered with The Army & Air Force Exchange Service (AAFES) to provide AAFES Exchange Gift Cards valued at \$150 for first place and \$75 for second place and \$25 for third place winners with the best video submissions.

The Contest begins on June 20, 2022, at 12:01:00 a.m. Eastern Time ("ET") and the period for entering the Contest ends on August 19, 2022, at 11:59 p.m. ET (the "Entry Period").

At the end of the Entry Period, a panel (comprised of AFAS staff) will select the winners. No more than three submission winners will be chosen by our panel of reviewers. This contest is open to all military members and their families.

Video submissions must explain — in an innovative, engaging, and inspiring manner — how Air Force Aid Society has impacted you or your family. All video submissions must be suitable for all audiences.

The winners will be notified by email and announced online by AFAS. Prizes for finalists will be provided by our partner Army & Air Force Exchange Service! By participating in the contest,



each entrant unconditionally accepts and agrees to comply with and abide by these Official Rules and the decisions of the AFAS which shall be final and binding in all respects.

2. Eligibility:

To participate, you must be at least 18 years of age. Employees of Air Force Aid Society and Board members, their immediate family members or people living in the same household are not eligible. The Contest is void where prohibited. Eligible prize winners must be one of the following:

- Active duty Air Force members
- Guard and Reserve members
- Retired Air Force members (not on a continuing basis, pending case specific review)
- Spouse of Air Force or Space Force member who is enrolled in DEERS and hold valid military dependent ID card (with a Power of Attorney)
- Dependent family members enrolled in DEERS holding valid military dependent ID card

3. How to Enter:

Participants must go to www.afas.org during the Entry Period for the contest submission details. Participants must (1) Follow @AFAS_hq on Instagram, (2) Like the giveaway post, (3) produce a video that is (a) original, (b) no more than 80 seconds in duration, (c) featuring a video showing of how AFAS has impacted them, then (4) post that video on www.youtube.com (and comply with all rules and regulations of the respective site, including permission to use any music included in the video, as well as rights to show the individuals depicted in the video); videos can be captured in TikTok or Instagram Reels but must be then uploaded to YouTube and (5) allow AFAS to use the video for publicity. All participants must visit the contest website and complete an online registration form, which will have a form field for the applicable YouTube URL, to enter.

By submitting an entry, you confirm that you have the authority, including any required permission of individuals depicted in the video, to publicly display the video. You also confirm that you have the right to incorporate into your video and publicly perform any music accompaniment in the video.

By submitting any video for the contest, participants hereby grant to AFAS and its affiliates, subsidiaries, licensees, and assigns, an irrevocable, perpetual and royalty-free right to use, reproduce, edit, display, transmit, prepare derivative works of, modify, publish and otherwise make use of the submitted video in all media, whether now known or hereinafter created,



throughout the world and for any purpose. In addition to other things, the rights granted to AFAS include but are not limited to the right to censor, compress, edit, feature, caption, affix logos to, and to otherwise alter or make use of the submitted video.

In addition, by submitting any video to AFAS, participants hereby represent and warrant that the submitted video or information does not and shall not infringe on any copyright or other right of any third party, and participant has the right to grant all rights and licenses granted to AFAS herein, including but not limited to all necessary rights under copyright, free and clear of any claims or encumbrances. AFAS may, but shall have no obligation to, post, display or otherwise make publicly available any video submitted by you, and may, in its sole and unfettered discretion, remove, edit, modify, or delete any portion of the video or information that you submitted.

4. Privacy:

Information provided to enter the Contest will not be sold to third parties but may be shared as necessary for the purposes of conducting and judging the Contest or making use of the submitted video as permitted by these Official Rules.

By submitting the video, the entrant acknowledges and agrees that any video submitted may be made available for viewing, voting and comment on by the public, and understands that comments with which the entrant disagrees or are unhappy about may be published or otherwise become associated with any submitted video. Entrants hereby waive any privacy expectations that they may have with respect to any video submitted to AFAS.

5. Automated Entries Prohibited:

No mechanically reproduced, incomplete, forged, software generated, or automated multiple entries will be accepted.

6. Winner Selection:

Winning placements among the finalists will be determined through a panel comprised of judges selected by AFAS.

7. Prize Details:

Prizes for finalists will consist of Exchange Gift Cards valued at \$150 for first place and \$75 for second place and \$25 for third place.



8. General Prize Conditions:

Potential Winners will be required to execute an Affidavit of Eligibility, Release of Liability and Prize Acceptance Form (collectively, the “Prize Claim Documents”). If a Winner fails or refuses to sign and return the Prize Claim Documents within three (3) days of prize notification, the Winner may be disqualified, and another winner may be selected. Prizes are not transferable and not assignable. No substitutions of prizes will be allowed, except AFAS reserves the right to substitute prize(s) of comparable or greater value in the event a prize or any portion thereof becomes unavailable for any reason.

9. Release:

Acceptance of a prize constitutes the prize winner’s permission for AFAS to use the prize winner’s name and likeness for advertising and/or promotional purposes worldwide and in all forms of media in perpetuity without further compensation or authorization.

Participants agree that AFAS and its affiliates, and their officers, employees, Board members, and representatives, shall not be responsible for any losses, damages or injuries of any kind resulting from participation in the Contest or from participants’ acceptance, receipt, possession and/or use or misuse of any prize. Participants also agree that the AFAS entities have not made and shall not in any manner be liable for any warranty, guarantee, or representation, whether express or implied, with respect to any prize, including without limitation, the prize’s quality, or fitness for a particular purpose. AFAS reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who is found to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Contest or the submission site, to be acting in violation of these Official Rules, or who otherwise takes actions that do or are intended to disrupt or undermine the legitimate operation of the Contest. AFAS also reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any entry containing any obscene, offensive, or otherwise inappropriate comments or other matter.

11. Governing Law:

All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation, and enforceability of these Official Rules shall be governed and construed in accordance with the internal laws of the State of Virginia District without regard to the choice of law provisions thereof.

The winners will be notified by email and/or telephone and will be announced publicly online by AFAS.
