Hap Arnold Education Grant



The **Hap Arnold Education Grant** provides need-based financial assistance to help eligible children and spouses pursue undergraduate education.

The application also serves as the entry point for additional education opportunities, including the **Merit Scholarship**, **Grit Scholarship**, and **interest-free Supplemental Loan** programs.



Application Period

January 1 – April 30, 2026 (For the 2026 - 2027 academic year)

Award Amounts

Grant amounts vary each year and are based on student's financial need. Awards are determined by:

- ★ Total number of applicants
- ★ Approved grant budget
- ★ Applicant's *Student Aid Index (SAI)* from their *Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)* form
- ★ Cost of attendance at the accredited institution

Eligibility

Students must be pursuing a full-time undergraduate degree at a 2 or 4 year college, or vocational/trade school approved by the Department of Education. Applicants must meet one of the following criteria:

- ★ **Dependent children** of active-duty, Title 10 Guard/Reserve or extended active-duty, Title 32 AGR performing full-time active-duty, retired or deceased Air Force & Space Force members.
- ★ **Spouses** of active-duty Air Force & Space Force members, Title 10 Guard/Reserve or extended active-duty, or Title 32 AGR performing full-time active-duty.
- ★ **Surviving spouses** of active-duty or retired Air Force & Space Force members.

Documents Required

- ★ **Student's Military ID**
(copy of front & back)
- ★ **Service Member's Orders**
(copy and/or proof of service documents for appropriate category)
- ★ **School Transcript**
(with most recent grade point average)
- ★ **FAFSA** for applicable academic year
