

### Financial Assistance – Stability When it's Needed Most.

**\$6 million • 6,934 supported**

Grants and interest-free loans help families navigate unexpected challenges.



- ★ **Basic Living Expenses** | \$1.7 million | 2,415 supported
- ★ **Emergency Travel** | \$1.1 million | 1,138 supported
- ★ **Vehicle Expenses** | \$752K | 1,007 supported
- ★ **Car & Booster Seats** | \$264K | 1,053 supported

**Expanded Areas of Support:** Adoption fees, mental health counseling, immigration expenses, domestic violence relocation support, overseas car rentals, basic furniture for new households, and more!

### Education Support – Investing in the Future

**\$4.4 million • 1,614 supported**

Continuing education is vital to strengthening long-term stability, opportunity, and readiness for military families.




- ★ **Hap Arnold Education Grant** (Need-Based): Dependent on student's individual financial need. \$4.0 million | 1,506 supported
- ★ **Merit & Grit Scholarships:** Recognizing academic excellence or personal resilience. \$300K | 60 supported
- ★ **Supplemental Loans** – No interest loans to help with education expenses. \$55K | 46 supported

### Community Programs – Supporting Family Readiness

**\$1.1 million • 4,093 supported**

Programs designed to reduce stress and strengthen family well-being.



- ★ **Bundles for Babies:** Grant to expecting families who complete this parenting and financial education class. \$368K | 2,453 supported
- ★ **Child Care Assistance:** Financial support to help families access safe, reliable child care during PCS moves and other high-stress periods. \$522K | 1,373 supported
- ★ **Elevate:** Grant to couples who complete this skills-based relationship class. \$25K | 155 supported
- ★ **Spouse Tuition Assistance:** Support for spouses pursuing additional learning opportunities. \$200K | 112 supported

### Disaster Relief – Rapid Support in Times of Crisis

While no major disasters directly impacted our installations in 2025, we remained prepared to respond if families were affected. In 2024, \$4.5 million supported nearly 5,000 families impacted by Hurricanes Helene and Milton.
